



THE NATIONAL PIKE CHAPTER –

MEMBER PARTICIPATION / RECOGNITION PROGRAM:

My Brothers, for those that have seen the arrow, actively participate in our Chapter and in the Lodge is the vision which we share. Actions and deeds are the true measure for the fulfillment of our Obligation. We know you are worthy of the honor of being selected to our Brotherhood. To let others know of your devotion to the Order, the National Pike Chapter has developed a visible recognition for noteworthy participation and cheerful service as a Chapter leader.

- **Chapter Patch Black Border with loop** – to active members who attend 3 chapter meetings and are active in a chapter committee. This patch has an attached loop for uniform wear on right pocket.
- **Chapter Neckerchief** – to active members with *noteworthy* participation and cheerful service in a chapter committee or chapter leadership role over 1 to 2 years. This will be a plain neckerchief and will have the Black Border chapter patch attached to it.
- **Chapter Gilded Neckerchief** – to active members who earn the Chapter Neckerchief and continue in Chapter leadership for a program year after earning the Chapter Neckerchief. . This will be a special gilded neckerchief and will have the Black Border chapter patch attached to it.

Note: These three chapter items can only be earned and are not available for sale.

What is considered noteworthy participation in the National Pike Chapter?

In **ONE** calendar year, starting in January, log twelve (12) or more points from:

*** Note: newly inducted Ordeal members can count partial year from of completing Ordeal.**

- 7 or more points (10 are possible) – one point for each Chapter meeting attended.
- 5 points for completing Brotherhood conversion one year after Ordeal.
- 3 points for completing Brotherhood conversion two years or later after Ordeal.
- 3 points for serving as an Elangomat at the Chapter Ordeal
- 2 points for serving on staff at the NP Chapter Ordeal weekend – active service
- 2 points for Additional Ordeal weekend and service another chapter as an Elangomat
- 1 to 3 points for bring another Arrowman to a Chapter meeting or event that has not attend before. One point per Arrowman.
- Up to 5 more points (x events are available each year) – one point each for full participation in any one of the following events:
 - Lodge Spring Fellowship, Lodge Fall Fellowship and /or Lodge Picnic
 - Lodge Banquet
 - Chapter Service Day or other Chapter sponsored service
 - Chapter Banquet
 - Section Conclave attendance or staff
 - Service: Lodge Jingle Bell Beaver Day or other Lodge Service Day
 - Lodge Leadership Development Training
 - Section Leadership Training
 - NOAC attendance or staff
 - Any other Lodge or Chapter sponsored event.

In TWO calendar years, starting in January, log a minimum of twenty-four (24) points which includes completion of Brotherhood.

- 10 to 15 points – one point per Chapter meeting
- 3 points for completing Brotherhood conversion two years or later after Ordeal.
- 1 to 3 points for bring another Arrowman to a Chapter meeting or event that has not attend before. One point per Arrowman.
- 5 to 10 points from participation in the same list of events noted.

What is Chapter Leadership?

Set the Example by earning recognition with the Chapter Neckerchief

Provide Cheerful Service* leading the Chapter as:

- Chapter Chief or Vice Chief
- Committee Chair
- Committee member in strong support for two years
- Active Adults who are Advisers, Associate Advisers or Committee Advisers

* The Chapter Chief will confirm a Chapter's Leader's Cheerful Service by youth and his adviser, and the Chapter Adviser will confirm for adults and the Chief. They will consult with one another and with the Committee Chairmen.

Chapter Patches are presented when earned. Neckerchiefs are presented at the Chapter Ordeal and Banquet in December.
